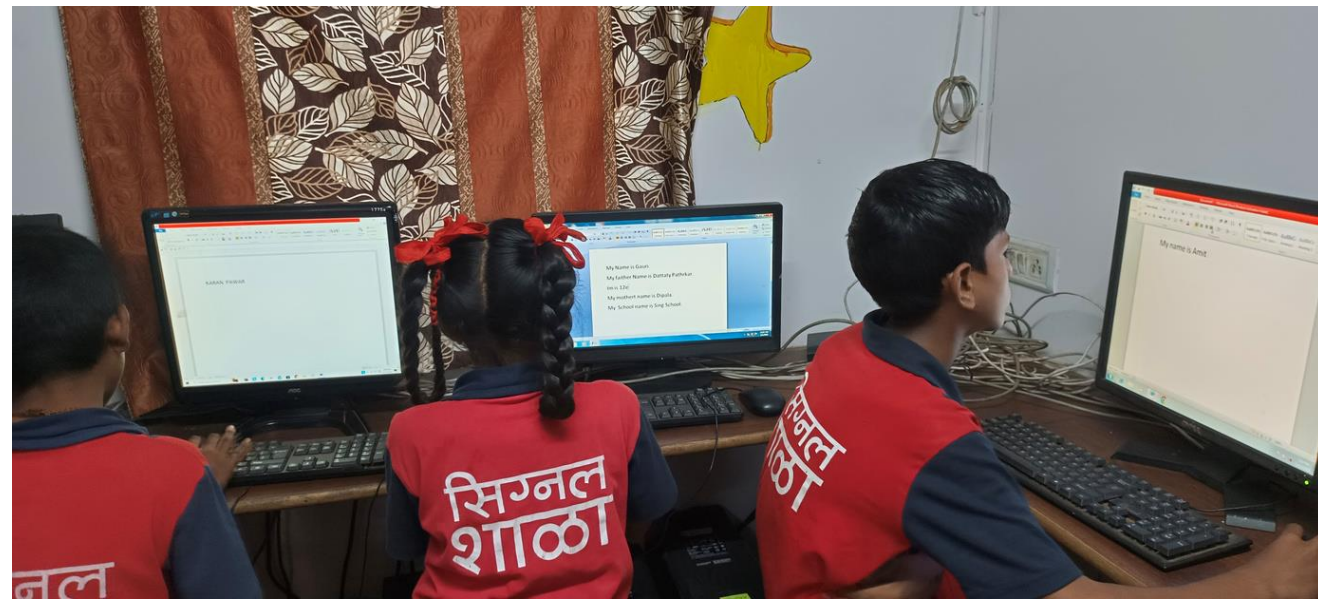
YOGA

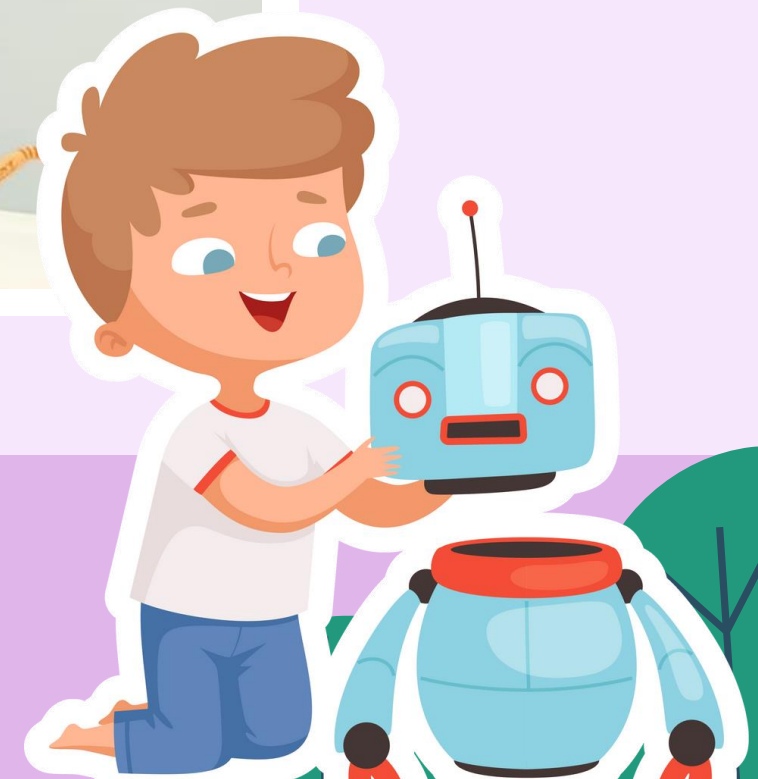
COMPUTER LEARNING

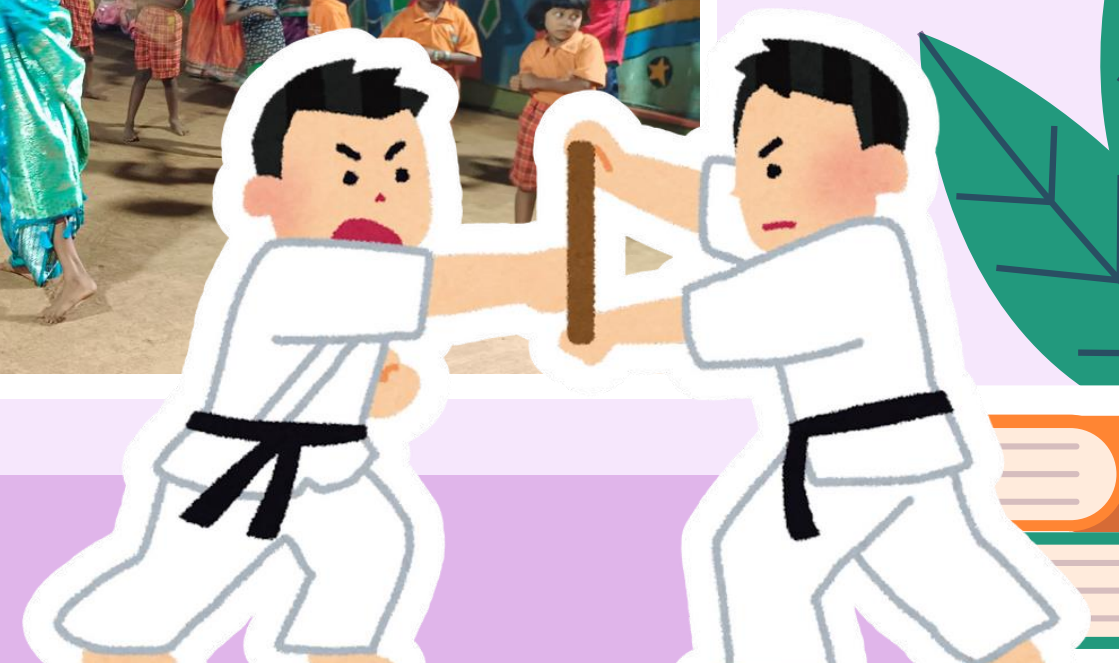
RANI LAXMIBAI PUNYATITHI

NUTRITIOUS DIET★



To ensure physical well-being, students are provided with a complete and diverse diet at school. They have breakfast in the morning after arriving at school, lunch in the afternoon, and snacks in the evening. The CEO of the organization, Sir Bhatu Sawant, personally explained to the newly enrolled students and the young children the essential basics of how to eat properly, how to take a bite, how to eat chapati and vegetables, which hand to use, the necessary portion size, and how to chew the food properly. He guided the children while eating with them.



CLEANLINESS EDUCATION

Due to living conditions on the streets, children in these family's lack cleanliness habits. Parents have no idea about child rearing or education. Emphasis is placed on inculcating cleanliness habits in school, such as classroom cleanliness. Students are taught that a clean environment fosters a pleasant atmosphere. Cleanliness and labor education should be ingrained from a young age. Therefore, a classroom cleanliness initiative is conducted once a month, involving primary and secondary students in cleaning classrooms and the school premises with teachers.



PAPER RECYCLING

★ In the perspective of preventing environmental damage, children got a firsthand experience of how much can be achieved at an individual level through the paper recycling workshop. The students engaged in discussions and brainstorming on how to reuse the scrap paper collected at school. Ananya Kajolkar and her colleague, along with college students, conducted the workshop. They explained the importance of 'paper' in our lives, the history of paper, its production process, and the adverse effects of paper production on land, water, trees, and wood. The students learned about these aspects during the paper recycling workshop. Using the collected scrap paper, the students created new paper from paper pulp. The newly made paper can be used for making greeting cards, decorations, and colored paper.



GREEN WALL

The ninth academic year of Signal School started with a pledge to combat pollution. On the occasion of World Environment Day, 'Signal Shala' became a 'Green Signal Shala' this year. The entire world is working towards addressing global warming. The noise of vehicles and air pollution around the school were disrupting teaching activities. As a solution, 'Signal Shala' has initiated the 'Green Wall' and 'Zero Waste' campaigns this year. By creating a vertical garden in the school premises, 3,000 plants have been planted. Various plant pots have been arranged outside the classrooms and in the school yard. Secondary class students have been trained in taking care of these plants, including watering them. On June 15, 2024, with the initiative of the Lions Club of Mandvi East and Thane Municipal Corporation, the Green Signal Shala and Zero Waste project were inaugurated at Samarth Bharat Vyaspith's Signal Shala.
